COVID-19 Mitigation Strategies

We understand that the health and safety of your guests, volunteers, and staff is your top priority. Physical distancing and frequent sanitization will continue to be effective tools against the spread of COVID-19. With that in mind, we're sharing recommendations for how to more safely implement Minotaur Mazes traveling exhibitions in your facility.

Maze Layout and Design Notes:

- One-way Directional flow – Q&A Layout helps facilitate one-way travel through the exhibit.
- Maze panels act as physical barriers between visitors traveling in different corridors.
- Reduce the number of high touch components - Omit fort building activities if cleaning is difficult.
- Remove hard to clean components - Reach-In Resource barrel, Squeeze n' Sniff, Dress-up Clothes and Slotted Walls.

Frequent Sanitation

- Sanitize frequently touched surfaces throughout the day (Interactives, prominent pipes, etc).
- Add hand sanitizer stations at the Entrance/Exit to Maze, and in interactive rooms/areas as needed so guests can sanitize their hands before and after participating.

Add extra signage

- Directional signs on the floor or walls throughout the maze can reinforce one-way traffic.
- Encourage hand sanitizing at sanitizing stations
- Encourage physical distancing generally and around specific exhibit components:
 - "One person or family at a time on climbing wall" sign
 - "One person or family at a time in climbing log" sign
 - "One person at a time in monorail area" sign
 - "One person or family at a time building forts" sign
- Create Safety Signs to tell your visitors what you're doing to keep them safe and how they can protect themselves

Sample Safety Sign content

For the safety of our visitors and staff:

- Exhibit surfaces are disinfected each day with interactive touch points disinfected throughout the day, using an EPA registered and green seal certified cleaner.
- Components that are difficult to clean have been removed.
- The Maze path encourages one-way travel to minimize contact. Please Go With the Flow!
- Please maintain a distance of 6 feet from other visitors throughout Maze and interactive areas.
- Please follow local requirements for use of masks.
- Hand sanitizing stations are provided throughout the exhibit for your use.
- User caution is recommended to minimize contact with surfaces and to sanitize hands during and after participation for general health and safety.
