



## COVID-19 Mitigation Strategies

We understand that the health and safety of your guests, volunteers, and staff is your top priority. Physical distancing and frequent sanitization will continue to be effective tools against the spread of COVID-19. With that in mind, we're sharing recommendations for how to more safely implement Minotaur Mazes traveling exhibitions in your facility.

### Changes to Maze of Illusions layout and design

- Single path Maze - Layout designed for one-way travel to minimize passing
- Maze panels act as physical barriers between visitors traveling in different corridors.
- Minimize number of high touch components
  - Maze layout can omit or reduce optical illusions that use hanging hands-on tools.
  - Stickers can be used on large spinning wheel to cover illusion graphics that have been removed.

### Frequent Sanitation

- Place hand sanitizer stations at entrance and exit to both Illusion Maze and Junior Maze and throughout the exhibition near high interaction components like puzzle tables and Make-a-Maze
- Sanitize frequently touched surfaces throughout the day (Interactives, prominent pipes, etc).

### Add extra signage

- Directional signs on the floor or walls throughout the maze can reinforce one-way traffic
- Encourage hand sanitizing at sanitizing stations
- Encourage physical distancing generally and around specific exhibit components:
  - "One person or family at a time in Web Maze" sign
  - "One person or family at a time on floor puzzles" sign
  - "One person or family at a time in Make-a-Maze" sign
- Exhibit-specific Safety Signs can alert visitors to efforts made to keep them safe and how they can protect themselves

### Sample Safety Sign content

For the safety of our visitors and staff:

- Exhibit surfaces are disinfected each day with interactive touch points disinfected throughout the day, using an EPA registered and green seal certified cleaner.
- Components that are difficult to clean have been removed.
- The Maze has been designed for one-way travel to minimize contact. Please Go With the Flow!
- Please maintain a distance of 6 feet from other visitors throughout Maze and interactive areas
- Please follow local requirements for use of masks.
- Hand sanitizing stations are provided throughout the exhibit for your use.
- User caution is recommended to minimize contact with surfaces and sanitize hands during and after participation for general health and safety.
